Date & Time: Thursday, 28th of November, 8:20 sharp

Itinerary: Guided tour of Toyosu Central Wholesale Market (Kouto Ward), which has been open to the public since 11th October 2018. Lunch at a buckwheat noodle (Soba) shop in the market, followed by a visit to Tokyo Origami Museum (Honjo, Sumida Ward). After a round trip in the museum, the tour will be completed (estimated to finish around 16:00, 10 mins walk to Asakusa Station, Tobu Skytree Line.
